SECHELT INDIAN BAND

LAW NO. 1987-01

Being a law to establish procedures for the execution of documents at meetings of the Band Council.

WHEREAS Division (5) of the Band Constitution empowers the Band Council to make laws regulating its meetings and their conduct;

NOW THEREFORE the Band Council enacts as a law of the Band the following:

- 1. The Band Council may provide a seal for the Band and, if it does so, shall provide for the safe custody of this seal.
- 2. All documents to be executed by the Band shall be presented to the Band Council at a meeting of the Band Council and the Band Council shall make available the seal.
- 3. The seal shall not be affixed to any document except when such impression is attested to by the signatures of the Chief and Councillors of the Band at a meeting of the Band Council.
- 4. The term "document" as used in Sections 2 and 3 and this Section 4 shall include deeds, mortgages, hypothecs, charges, conveyances, transfers and assignments of property, real or

personal, agreements, releases and receipts and discharges for the payment of money or other obligations, bonds, debentures and other debt obligations of the Band, and all paper writings.
