SECHELT INDIAN BAND

LAW NO. 1988-03

A LAW TO REGULATE ACCESS TO AND RESIDENCE ON SECHELT LANDS

WHEREAS Part III of the Band Constitution empowers the Band Council to make laws in relation to access to and residence on Sechelt Lands;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Sechelt Indian Band, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This law may be cited for all purposes as the "RESIDENCY LIST LAW".

2. In this law:

- (a) "Permittee" means a person who holds rights of occupancy to Sechelt Lands without the right of exclusive occupancy thereof; and
- (b) "Resident" means any person of eighteen years or older occupying premises on Sechelt Lands who is normally in occupation of such premises between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. and includes lessees, Permittees, Band Members and lawfully married husbands and wives of Band Members.
- 3. The Band Council shall keep a list of Residents who are resident on Band Lands during all or part of any year, such list to be referred to as the "Residency List".
- 4. Any person who is not a lessee, Permittee, Band Member or a lawfully married husband or wife of a Band Member and who desires to be a Resident on Sechelt Lands during all or any part of a year shall apply to be placed on the Residency List in respect of that year and shall pay the prescribed fees as hereinafter set out in this law.
- 5. The fee payable for the addition of an applicant's name to the Residency List is \$100.00 and the fee to remain on the Residency List thereafter shall be \$300.00 per year.
- 6. (1) Any person who is not a lessee, Permittee, Band Member or a lawfully married husband or wife of a Band Member and who is a Resident on Sechelt Lands and whose name is not contained in the Residency List within 6 months after the

coming into force of this law is guilty of a violation of this law.

- (2) Anyone guilty of a violation of this law is subject to the penalty of the imposition on summary conviction of a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days, or both.
- 7. This law shall come into force on the 1st day of March, 1989.
