LAW NO. 1989 - 02

A LAW TO REGULATE THE MEETINGS OF BAND COUNCIL
AND THE CONDUCT THEREOF

The Council of the Sechelt Indian Band, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This law may be cited for all purposes as the "PROCEDURE LAW NO.2".

Minutes

2. The minutes of the proceedings of all meetings of the Band Council shall be legibly recorded in a minute book. The minutes shall be signed by the Chief or the Councillor presiding at such meeting or at the next meeting at which they are adopted. With the exception of the minutes of a special meeting from which persons mentioned in Part II, Division (2), Section 4 of the Sechelt Band Constitution were excluded, the said minutes shall be open for the inspection of any person, who may make copies thereof and extracts therefrom at all reasonable times at payment each time of a fee of \$0.50 per page. At the start of every meeting, the Band Council may waive the taking of minutes.

Conflict of Interest

3. When a matter before the Band Council involves the spouse of the Chief or a Councillor, that Councillor or the Chief shall leave the meeting while the Band Council discusses and votes on the matter.

Read a second time this 1st day of May, 1989.
Read a third time this 3rd day of May, 1989.
