The Position

Under the general supervision of the Community Member Services Manager, responsible for the recreation component of Sechelt Indian Band (shishálh Nation) ("Nation") Programs and Services. The position works with other staff and agencies, both within the Nation and outside the community, to develop and implement holistic recreation programs. The position is responsible for the creation of effective and innovative recreation programs for children, youth, adults, and Elders. Programming is consistent with the four dimensions of health: physical, emotional, mental and spiritual and meets identified Community Member Services priorities. The position works to secure external funding for sustainable recreational programs and services through various grants and contribution agreements. The position organizes, implements and evaluates programming.

The Candidate

- Diploma in Recreational Leadership, or relevant Health/Social Science/humanities field, with recent relevant experience in community health-related work such as developing and implementing community-based health/social programs. An equivalent combination of education, training and experience will be considered.
- Experience in recreation program development, implementation and review.
- Experience writing and managing proposals an asset.
- Experience in areas of health promotion, holistic health and population health approach including the broad determinants of health is an asset.
- Experience working with governmental and non-governmental Community Health Programs.
